Roots and Wings

"T here are two things we should give our children: one is roots and the other is wings." So goes the adage. It is in

knowing our roots that we know who we are. It is with wings that we then shape the future—a future sprouting from those roots but also blossoming into something new. If there were only the roots, we would never know life's richness. Without wings, never would we come to beauty.

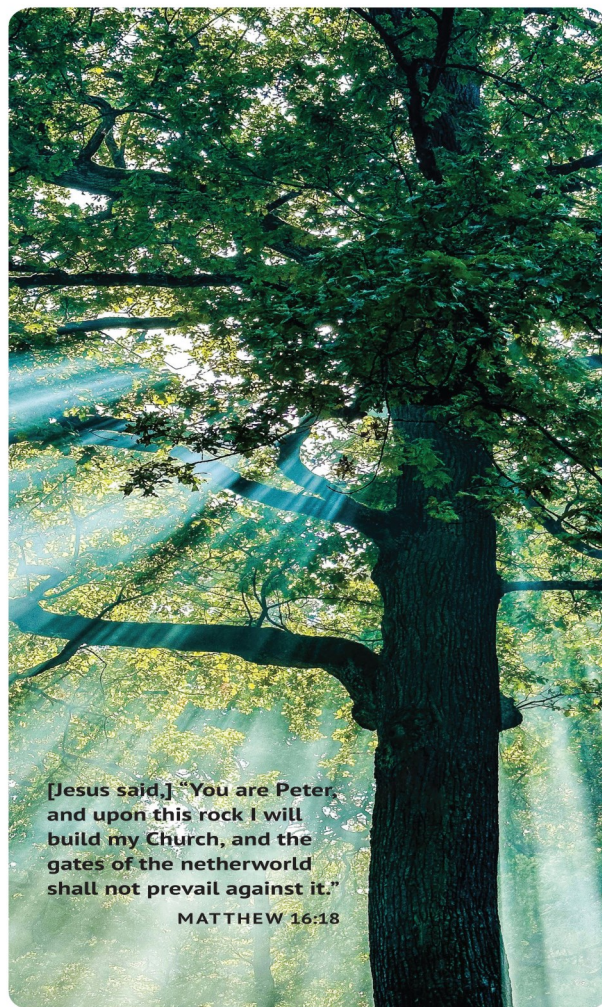
The solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul honors both of these dynamics in the Church. It was Peter who was the Rock, who was able to recognize God's presence made flesh among us, who would say to Jesus, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:16).

It was Paul who pushed the envelope, who proclaimed that God's saving love was for Jews and Gentiles—both members of the household of God—without distinction. It was Paul who argued that circumcision was not necessary for a believer. It was Paul who recognized that the Law was indeed a blessing, yet also that obeying the Law does not save us—it is the love of Christ Jesus that saves us.

Many are rooted through faith in Christ Jesus. Some live out that faith as Catholics, others as Lutherans or Methodists, still others as Orthodox or Anglicans. All of us rooted in Christ, all of us living out faith, each blossoming in our own fruitfulness as guided by the Spirit, for the purpose of tradition is to pass on the flame and not to preserve the ashes. ●

The most recent data show that MAiD is the 6th highest cause of death in Canada, with Health Canada reporting in 2022 that 13,241 patients died by MAiD lethal injections. That figure accounted for 4.1% of all deaths in Canada that year and represented a 31.2% increase from 2021, the first year MAiD was available to those who were not terminally ill.

Answers to the old Baltimore Catechism Questions:

1) The **attributes** of the Catholic church are:

Authority—The Pope and the bishops, as lawful successors of the apostles, have power from Christ Himself to teach, to sanctify, and to govern the faithful in spiritual matters.

Infallibility—The Church, by the special assistance of the Holy Spirit, cannot err when it teaches or believes a doctrine of faith or morals.

Indefectibility—The Church, as Christ founded it, will last until the end of time.

2) The **marks** of the Catholic Church are:

One - All its members, according to the will of Christ, profess the same faith, have the same sacrifice and sacraments, and are united under one and the same visible head, the Pope.

Holy - It was founded by Jesus Christ, who is all-holy, and because it teaches according to the will of Christ, holy doctrines, and provides the means of leading a holy life, thereby giving holy members to every age.

Catholic (universal) - Destined for all-time, it never fails to teach the divine commandment to teach all nations all the truths revealed by God.

Apostolic—It was founded by Christ on the apostles and, according to His divine will, has always been governed by their lawful successors.
